INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. DESCRIPTION:** Nose Mask

- 5. TOOLS REQUIRED:**
- Scissors
 - phillips screwdriver

6. PRE-INSTALLATION CAUTIONS/NOTES:

- The area to be covered by the mask must be free of dirt. The flannel surface of the nose mask must be especially clean.
- Both the vehicle and the mask must be completely dry. If moisture is present under the mask and is allowed to dry, it may cause the paint to cloud. If mask gets wet, remove and allow to dry completely.
- Any repainted surface in contact with mask must be completely cured.
- DO NOT pull the mask from any of the openings when installing the mask. This may result in DAMAGE to your mask.
- If the nose mask should flap due to high speed or wind conditions, stop car and adjust or remove mask.




CARE OF NOSE MASK:

- To clean the vinyl and flannel backing, use a cleaner such as "409" or "Fantastic".
- The vinyl surface may be cleaned by simply spraying the cleaner onto the vinyl and wiping off with a cloth or sponge.
- To clean the flannel backing, liberally spray the cleaner on the area to be cleaned. If heavily soiled, use a cloth or sponge with the cleaner and rub the soiled area gently. Repeat if necessary. Rinse completely with clear water when finished. Hang to dry, but not in direct sunlight. Before installation, ensure both the vehicle and the nose mask are completely dry. If there is moisture under the nose mask and it is not allowed to dry, paint clouding can occur.


CAUTION

- Attach all elastics with hooks and clips carefully and securely. Accidental release may cause injury.


7. INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:




- 1) Remove license plate and license plate bracket (if applicable).
 - a) Remove 2 license plate screws.
 - b) Remove 2 license plate bracket screws.
- 2) Secure mask in wheel well areas.
 - a) Install screw through hole in plastic clip to prevent clip from moving.
 - b) Attach web strap with hook to metal edge of wheel well above/behind plastic clip.
 - c) Perform steps a) and b) on other side.
- d) Attach 4 clips to inside edge of fascia.
- e) Pull down on bottom corner of mask.
- f) Perform steps d) and e) on other side.
- 3) Secure mask at lower fascia opening.
 - a) Attach 4 elastics with hooks to grille of lower fascia opening at indicated locations.



- 4) Secure mask at grill.
 - a) Insert 5 pads into gap under grill.



- 5) Secure mask at headlights.
 - a) Insert 2 pads into gap under headlight.
 - b) Perform step a) on other side.



- 6) Reinstall license plate and license plate bracket (if applicable).
 - a) Poke holes through mask into center license plate bracket grommets.
 - b) Cut clearance holes (1" - 2") so that license plate bracket pads will rest on fascia.
 - c) Reinstall license plate bracket and plate.
