- 90% (or greater) Isopropyl Alcohol


PRE-INSTALLATION WARNINGS, CAUTIONS, CRITICAL STEPS, and NOTES:


• Dealer Installation Recommended. Instructions may refer to Service Manual.

CAUTION

- Install the rear bumper protector only when the part & vehicle temperature are between 60°F 110°F (16°C 43°C).
- Do not wash or expose the vehicle to a wet environment for 24 hours after installing the bumper protector.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:






- 2) Bumper protector installation prep.
 - a) Open rear hatch.
 - b) Using a clean lint-free cloth and 90% Isopropyl Alcohol, clean area of rear bumper where part will be installed.
 - c) Allow time to dry thoroughly.


A CAUTION

• Failure to clean the mounting surface properly may cause the adhesive tape to have poor adhesion to the vehicle.


INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:




- 3) Dry fit bumper protector on vehicle by aligning bumper protector centering arrow with tailgate latch.
- 4) Position center spacer template against edge of bumper as shown and secure with masking tape.



5) Position edge spacer templates against edge of bumper at both ends of bumper protector as shown and secure with masking tape.




- 5) Prepare tape.
 - a) Remove part.
 - b) Peel back approximately 30mm on tape liners 1 and 2 (wide tape). (Fig 4 & 5)
 - c) Fold back liners. (Fig 5)




- 7) Re-align part to vehicle and lightly tack bumper protector to vehicle at both ends.
- 8) Confirm center arrow alignment to vehicle and tight fit to bumpers. If necessary, un-tack bumper protector and repeat instruction 7.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:




- 9) While holding part in position, with one hand at center, remove tape liner 1 then 2 and tack down.
- 10) Remove spacer templates.



11) Pull up on corner of part and remove liners 3 and 4 and tack down. (Fig. 7.)

NOTE:


Pull up along front edge of part as you pull tape liner so liners do not break.



12) Using a clean lint-free cloth, start at center and apply 15lbs of force along tape lengths.

NOTE:

To ensure adequate adhesion, re-apply 15 lbs of force across entire part.



- 13) Remove protective film by pulling horizontally and discard.
- 14) Close rear hatch.
- 15) Do not expose vehicle to moisture for 24 hours.
