

PRE-INSTALLATION WARNINGS, CAUTIONS, CRITICAL STEPS, and NOTES:

• Dealer installation recommended. Instructions may refer to Service Manual.

A CAUTION


- Please wash vehicle with soap and water prior to bumper protector installation.
- Do not wash vehicle for at least 24 hours after installing bumper protector. Doing so can lead to poor adhesion between bumper protector and vehicle.
- Install bumper protector only when part and vehicle temperature are between 16°C 43°C (60°F 110°F).
- Failure to clean mounting surface properly can lead to poor adhesion between bumper protector and vehicle.
- Failure to apply sufficient pressure to wet out all tape lengths can cause bumper protector to not adhere properly.
- Do not tack front tape strips to vehicle before rear tape strips. Tacking front tape strips first will prevent removal of rear tape liners.
- To allow time for adhesive to cure, maintain vehicle temperature between 16°C 43°C (60°F 110°F) for at least 2 hours after installing bumper protector.



- 1) Open rear hatch door.
- 2) Clean attachment area of vehicle (shaded area).
 - a) Wash with soap and water to remove any dirt and debris. Allow time to dry.
 - b) Cleanse with clean lint free cloth and 90% or greater isopropyl alcohol. Allow time to dry.

NOTE:


Failure to clean mounting surface properly can lead to poor adhesion between bumper protector and vehicle.



3) Dry fit bumper protector on vehicle. Align bumper protector center arrow with tailgate latch striker.

NOTE:

Do not remove tape liners.




4) At both ends of bumper protector, position installation template between front wall of rear bumper and front corner of bumper protector.

NOTE:


Installation templates should fit tightly between bumper protector and front wall of rear bumper.

5) Secure installation templates to bumper with masking tape.


6) Remove bumper protector.



 At both ends of bumper protector, fold front tape liner so it will extend beyond front edge of part without exposing adhesive.



- 8) Prepare rear tape.
 - a) At both ends of bumper protector, peel back rear tape liner approximately 25 mm (1 in).
 - b) At both ends of bumper protector, fold rear tape liner so it will extend beyond front edge of part.




9) Realign bumper protector to tailgate latch striker and installation templates, and apply gentle pressure to lightly tack both ends of part to vehicle.

NOTE:

Do not apply firm pressure.


10) Confirm center arrow alignment and tight fit to installation templates. If necessary, untack bumper protector and repeat.




11) While gently lifting up on front edge of bumper protector, remove rear tape liners by slowly pulling along length of part towards center.

NOTE:


Do not tack front tape strips to vehicle before rear tape strips. Tacking front tape strips first will prevent removal of rear tape liners.



12) Using clean lint free cloth, apply 1 kg/cm² (15 lb/in²) of firm pressure along rear tape path. Start from center and work outward in one direction. Repeat in opposite direction.



- 13) Remove and discard installation templates.
- 14) While gently lifting up on front edge of bumper protector, remove front tape liners by slowly pulling along length of part towards center.



- 15) Using clean lint free cloth, apply 1 kg/cm² (15 lb/in²) of firm pressure along front tape path. Start from center and work outward in one direction. Repeat in opposite direction.
- To ensure adequate adhesion, reapply 1 kg/cm² (15 lb/in²) of firm pressure across entire bumper protector.

NOTE:

Failure to apply sufficient pressure to wet out all tape lengths can cause bumper protector to not adhere properly.

- 17) Remove and discard protective film.
- 18) Close rear hatch.
- 19) Maintain vehicle temperature between 16°C 43°C (60°F 110°F) for at least 2 hours, and do not expose vehicle to moisture for at least 24 hours. This will allow time for tape to cure.
