A WARNING							
<ul> <li>Each Shopping Bag Hook is designed to transport normal cargo contents. Flammable or dangerous materials should not be transported in your vehicle at any time.</li> <li>Do not exceed the recommended load of 15 lbs per Shopping Bag Hook.</li> <li>Do not use pilot point drill bits during installation process. These drill bits can leave large burrs and cause enlarged holes. Use HSS drill bits made for drilling steel only.</li> </ul>							
• Do not overtighten the Hex Head Screw. Maximum torque is 1.6 to 1.8Nm (14 to 16inlbs).							

 Remove (7) push pins from package shelf using a clip removal tool or a flat head screw driver and save to reuse (Fig. 1).



2) Place a drop cloth in trunk to catch metal shavings.



Drill out (2) push pin holes (see Fig. 2) using a 3/8" HSS drill bit . Do not drill center or outer (4) holes.

Note:

Do not use pilot point drill bits. Use HSS bits for drilling steel only.

4) Pull down trunk trim and remove metal burrs using a deburring tool or file if necessary.



- 5) Attaching Jack Nuts to package shelf.
  - a) Feed hex head screw through large hole in jack nut friction wrench and thread (hand tight) into jack nut.
  - b) Pull down trunk trim.
  - c) Starting with Driver Side push pin hole, insert jack nut/screw assembly into push pin hole, keeping jack nut firmly pressed against sheet metal.
  - d) Use 5/16" socket with a torque wrench and tighten hex head screw in until jack nut is fully collapsed at a maximum between 1.6 to 1.8Nm (14 to 16inlb).
  - e) Remove hex head screw from jack nut and save for passenger side.
  - f) Repeat steps 4a) to 4d) for passenger side and then discard hex head screw afterwards.

## **CAUTION**

• Do not overtighten the Hex Head Screw. Maximum torque is 1.6 to 1.8Nm (14 to 16inlb).

- 6) Align Driver Side Drill Template.
  - a) Go to Page 7, make sure drill template is printed to scale and cut out Driver Side drill template.
  - b) Poke hole in center of template and insert phillips screw.
  - c) Thread phillips screw/template into jack nut.
  - Adjust drill template so that arrow is pointing towards rear of vehicle and tighten screw to hold template in place.
- 7) Mark center of anti-rotation hole with center punch/hammer.
- 8) Remove screw and drill template.
- 9) Drill anti-rotation hole using 3/16" drill bit.
- 10) Pull down trunk trim and remove metal burrs using a deburring tool.





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- 11) Align Passenger Side Drill Template.
  - a) Go to Page 7, make sure drill template is printed to scale and cut out Passenger Side drill template.
  - b) Poke hole in center of template and insert phillips screw.
  - c) Thread phillips screw/template into jack nut.
  - d) Adjust drill template so that arrow is pointing towards rear of vehicle and tighten screw to hold template in place.
- 12) Mark center of anti-rotation hole with center punch/hammer.
- 13) Remove screw and drill template.
- 14) Drill anti-rotation hole using 3/16" drill bit.
- 15) Pull down trunk trim and remove metal burrs using a deburring tool.
- 16) Make a small cut in trunk trim for anti-rotation pin.

17) Push trunk trim back up, reinstall 5 push pins and discard remaining 2 push pins (Fig. 9).









- 18) Attach Shopping Bag Hook to Package Shelf.
  - a) With shopping bag hook in stowed position, insert phillips screw, align with jack nut and anti-rotation hole and fully hand tighten (Passenger side shown).

19) Repeat step 18) for Driver side.

- 20) Shopping Bag Hook use:
  - a) When in use, move shopping bag hooks into "down" position.
  - b) When not in use, place shopping bag hooks in "stowed" position.

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
